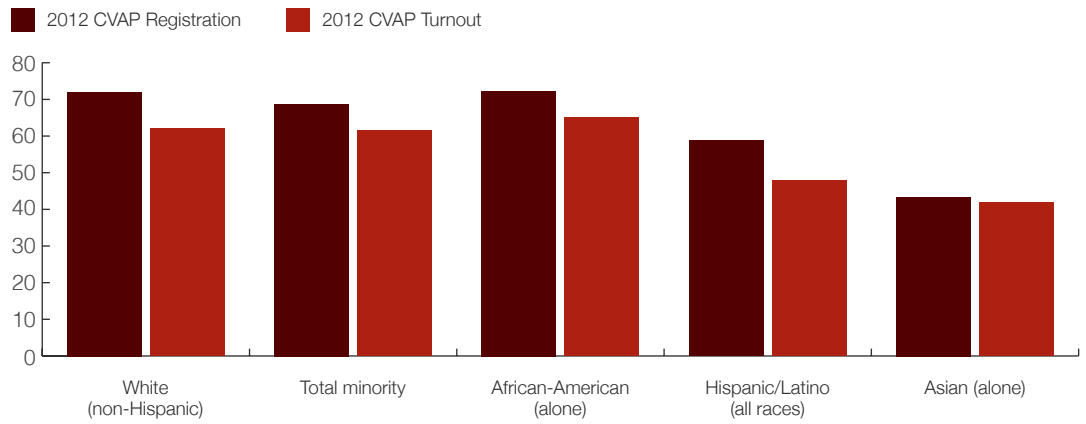
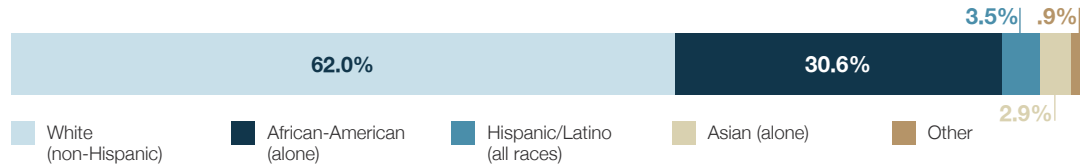




2012 Registration and Turnout Rates among Citizens of Voting Age Population (CVAP)

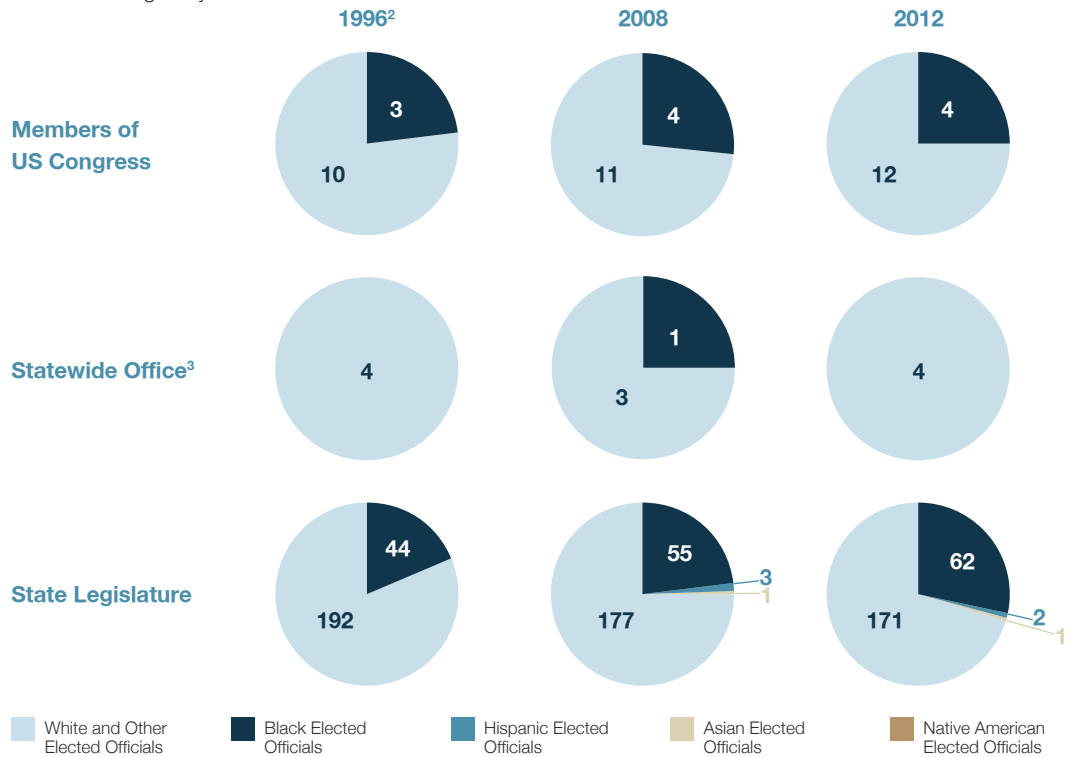


Total 2012 Citizens of Voting Age Population (CVAP)

Prior Coverage Under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act

The entire state of Georgia, with the exception of the City of Sandy Springs (which was bailed out in 2010), was covered by Section 5 at the time of the *Shelby County* decision.

Coverage Under Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act

Currently, none of Georgia is covered under Section 203.
