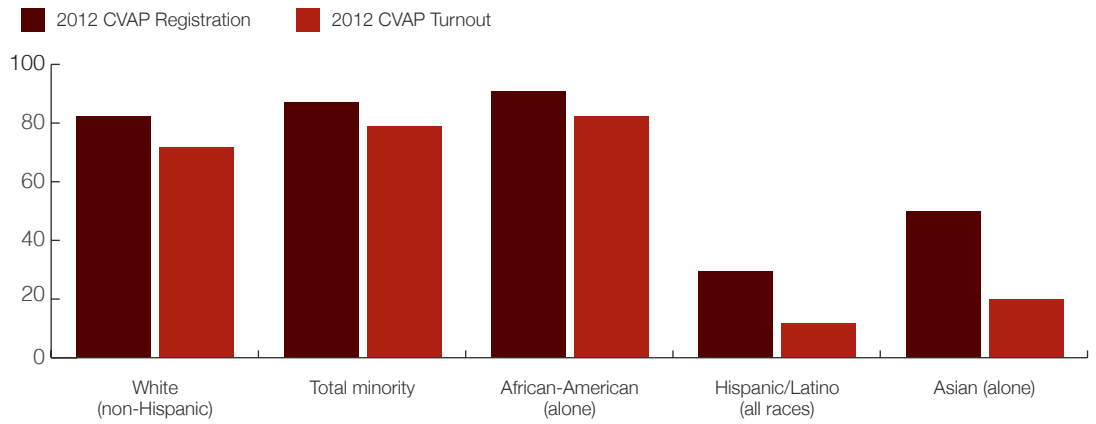
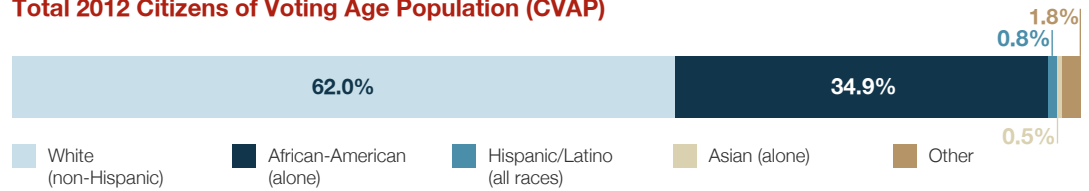




## 2012 Registration and Turnout Rates among Citizens of Voting Age Population (CVAP)

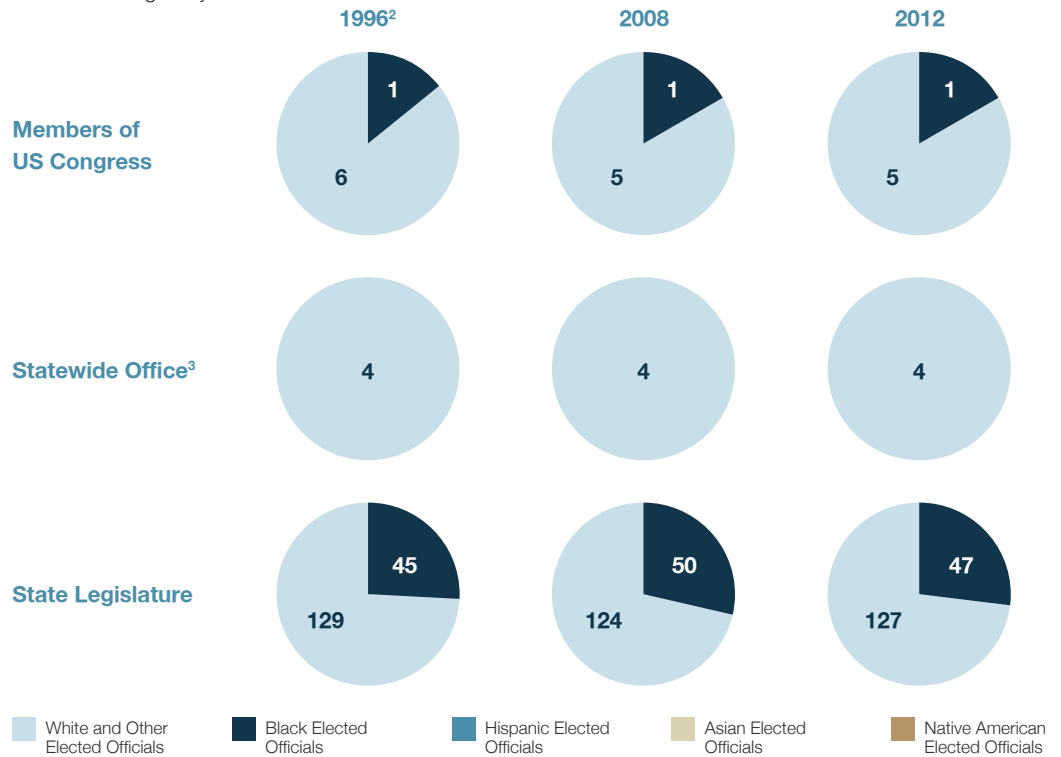


## Total 2012 Citizens of Voting Age Population (CVAP)

### Prior Coverage Under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act

The entire state of Mississippi was covered by Section 5 at the time of the *Shelby County* decision.

### Coverage 2011 to Present Under Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act

Currently, ten counties in Mississippi are required by Section 203 to provide minority language assistance for the American Indian community.
